## **Duties of Icknield Way Route Wardens – Draft 3 Jun 2022**

1. Walking the section of route at least once a year, ideally twice – really depends on the likelihood of issues
2. Highlighting problems on route – such as fallen trees, missing damaged waymark posts, finger signs, blockages, encroaching vegetation. Liaising with the Highway Authority or any other contacts to get the problems resolved
3. Responding to any queries from the Highway Authority, Icknield Way Association members, or walkers who contact the IWA about issues associated with the route
4. In conjunction with the Highway Authority replace missing/faded Icknield Way waymark discs to ensure the route is clear to users
5. Informing the Website Officer of temporary changes (e.g., temporary closures) to the route and when the problem has been cleared – so the website can inform Icknield Way members/users
6. Highlight if there are significant changes on the route (new build, permanent path changes) which require amendments to the text/maps in the guide
7. Reviewing and checking the guide book text for accuracy and clarity prior to preparing a new edition.
8. Liaise with the Route Maintenance Officer and/or Secretary with any issues or concerns with the route.
9. Consider any improvements or changes to the route which would enhance the Icknield Way
